Clinicians with experience at the NCAA division 1, 2, 3 and junior college levels, high school state championships, the WNBA, and the NBA have been invited throughout the weekend to work with you on the court and in the classroom to provide the highest quality of officiating training available at any camp anywhere in the country.

The Games...

The games you will officiate are being played as part of the annual UMD Team Camp for high school teams from all over the Upper Midwest. Games will use 2 or 3 officials and high school mechanics. New and veteran officials will benefit from this camp experience.

What you should bring...

Each referee should bring an adequate supply of equipment including black and white striped shirts, black pants (shorts are fine), black referee shoes, a whistle, and towels (add linens & pillows if staying in the dorm).

Camp Details...

University of Minnesota - Duluth
July 16 – 18, 2010

You will officiate a minimum of 5 games per session that you register for!

Session 1 registration is 3:00 – 3:45 p.m. on Friday
Pre-Camp meeting Friday 4:00 p.m. to 5:45 p.m.
Games Friday 7:00 p.m. to Saturday 3:30 p.m.
Be prepared to stay for games until 3:30 on Saturday

Session 2 registration is 12:15 – 1:00 p.m. on Saturday
Pre-Camp meeting Saturday 1:15 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
Games Saturday 3:30 p.m. to Sunday 12:30 p.m.
Be prepared to stay for games until 12:30 on Sunday

Mechanics and court coverage sessions will be included in the pre-camp meetings. Other classroom sessions scheduled throughout the weekend.

Video: Back by popular demand will be the opportunity to review at least one of your games on DVD with a camp clinician. Each official will receive a copy of that DVD at the end of their review session.

Lodging: On-campus dorm rooms for only \$20 per night or local hotels are also available.

Meals: All-you-can-eat on-campus cafeteria buffets for a reasonable price.

Lodging and meals not included in camp fee. Please pay UMD for lodging expenses when you arrive.

Cost: \$95 for one Session or \$160 for both Sessions if registration form & camp fee received by July 1.
After July 1: \$120 for one Session or \$185 for both Sessions.
